

## **Slovenian for foreigners**

If your mother tongue is not Slovenian and you are not familiar with it you can take part in our „Slovenian for foreigners“ classes at different levels.

The classes are carried out according to publicly recognised programme. The basic course contains three 80 hour levels. If you successfully pass the level placement test, which is free of charge, you will be able to take part in upper or advanced courses.

The course is suitable for adults whom **Slovenian is the second or foreign language** and would like to communicate and exchange experience with the native speakers of Slovene as well as get to know cultural, social, economic and political image of Slovenia. Other reasons can be following:

- further studying in Slovenia
- obtaining a work placement
- acquisition of Slovene citizenship

At the end of the course you will receive **The Certificate of Successfully Completed Course**, which has internal validity. In order to get a publicly recognised certificate the participants have to take an exam of Slovene language skills (external examination) with one of the lecturers responsible for these examinations.

The main aim of the course is **to develop communication skills in Slovene**. Therefore the participants learn the language in usage, e.g. in the process of communication, by simulating various every day situations. The programme „Slovenian for foreigners“ includes four communication skills : speaking, writing, listening and reading. Each level uses the newest reference books, which are not included in the price.

The courses take place twice a week for two or three 45 minute lessons. The exact schedule is set before the beginning of the course. The groups are small, **from 6 to 12 participants**, which enables us to focus on each individual.

The courses are carried out by professors of Slovene language. When forming the groups we consider the mother tongue of the individual in order to find lecturers who are able to communicate and explain the basics using that particular language.
